Motion was made and passed to donate \$500.00 to the Catholic Relief Fund to help those in need in Haiti.

Motion was made and passed to donate \$100.00 to John Caporaso, our Brothers son who was recently deployed to serve our Country in Iraq.

Membership blitz to take place on the weekend of February 27th and 28th at St James Church Committee Chairman John Abram had requested volunteers to assist at all Masses.

Springfield Council #5560 has exceeded its membership by 108% and its Insurance goal 125%. We are currently in line for a 5 star award from Supreme Council.

God is the Lord of Today, the God of Present Tense. "I AM" is the name God uses in the ancient stories of Israel. The Eternal One exists in an everlasting state of Now, which is why God expects things of us today more than any other day. However, many of us often get stuck in the past. We're overcome by waves of nostalgia for a world that was: for youth, strength, ability, beauty, and opportunity come and gone. We can get caught up by grievance and indignation for what others have done or failed to do. We're mired in loss and can't seem to break free from remorse.

And yet, we also can get caught living in the future. We may focus on what we want, or dream of what would be better. Again, we can become unfocused on the present and may miss opportunities that arrive in the present that could bring the future we want..

God's good word is reason to celebrate now. Forget what was (God is willing to do so!) and what will be (it's not guaranteed!) and rejoice in the Holy Now—because that's where God is to be found. Today and now are the only points in time when God can be encountered, so they are the only moments where grace operates and change can take place.

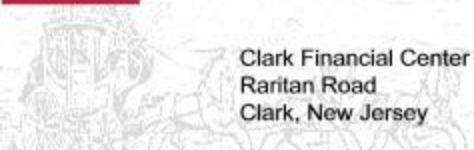
